INFORMATION CLAUSE FOR THE PERSON REQUESTING THE SERVICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 13 OF THE GDPR

3. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of:
 - a) conclusion and execution of the agreement concerning provision of VIP Line services pursuant to Article 6 par. 1 letter b) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter: the GDPR).
 - b) in case of potential disputes we can also process your personal data for the purpose of pursuing claims or protecting our rights in accordance with Article 6 par. 1 letter f) of the GDPR, which constitutes our, so called, legitimate interest, involving pursuing claims and protecting our rights.
4. Your data may be disclosed to agencies authorised to control PPL activities, including the Civil Aviation Authority, Social Insurance Company (ZUS), the Tax Office, the Border Guard, advisers, external consultants (legal, tax, financial advisers).
5. Your personal data will be stored for a period of 5 years calculated from the agreement termination date. Data processed for the purpose of pursuing claims (eg. in court proceedings) will be stored until the claims fall under the statute of limitations, as specified in the provisions of the civil code.
6. You have the right to access the content of your data, the right to correct or delete it, limit its processing and the right to demand the transfer of data. You also have the right to object to your data being processed based on our legitimate interest. You can exercise your rights by contacting the personal data protection officer, sending a letter to our seat's address or using the contact form available at our website. Should you determine that processing personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR, you also have the right to file a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
